I was drowning in the rapids of a raging river. And I was angry. Why didn't God rescue me?

I was raised in the church. My mother was a Reverend, a Pastor, and a Chaplain. I gave my life to the Lord when I was 5. My life always seemed blessed. Oh, there were trials, but God always carried me through them. Until.

My mother got dementia. I was her sole caretaker. The undertow took me. I sank further as my mother declined. I begged God for help. It didn't come. My anger grew. Seven years later, my mother passed after a heart-wrenching end. I felt abandoned and cheated by the God I thought I knew. One year later, my faith sunk along with my heart. I was so angry I didn't know who I was anymore. I thought God wouldn't help, but I NEEDED it.

I called SCSM and signed up for the Bereavement Class. I was a bundle of raw

nerves. My pain and anger were so close to the surface that I couldn't stop the tears. Chaplain Liz opened the doors to my pain and heartache. Each week the doors opened a little more. I found friends who were walking the same path. And still, I felt raw.

I went for counseling at SCSM. My counselor walked me through the heartache, the forgiveness for myself and others, the acceptance of my journey in God's plan, the release of not understanding God's plan, and the laying down of responsibility for gifts only He gives - forgiveness, faith, salvation. Allowing God to give them to me again, not trying to create them myself freed me.

As I passed through the last step, I began to see that God gave me my broken spirit so I could clearly see others' broken spirits, and I could comfort and heal as SCSM had comforted and healed me. For the first time, I truly understood the depth of the gift of healing Jesus said we would give to others. The very day I knew SCSM was the only place I wanted to work was the day SCSM posted the job.

Now here I am taking one more step on my journey in His plan into the river of healing. If you are in need of healing, let SCSM give to you as they gave to me.

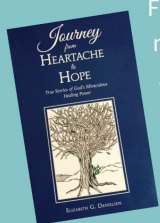

The damage was done. Our hearts were broken. I was living in sin, bondage, and drug addiction. She didn't know what to do next except be a mom and try to survive and function while I was in my darkest moments. Through it all, God knew that this day of restoration would occur! There is not one inch of wasted pain that my wife and I have experienced. There is always

praying together every day from 3,000 miles away, and God had softened both of our hearts! God softened Stephanie's heart, and she forgave me of all of my sins. She learned deep down in her heart that we truly fight against principalities, not flesh and blood. Then, and only then, could she understand that the enemy had me in chains for many years. I have a brand new heart and a brand new mind. However, the greatest miracle even bigger than my miracle is God was preparing her the whole time and working on her heart. Stephanie is brand new. I am more in love with her than I have ever been in my entire life even since the first time I met her!
